



Glossary of Important Terms

These terms may be used for both:

- [Image Evaluations](#) (occurring 6 times a year at monthly, CCR meetings), and for
- [End of Year Competition](#) (submissions due in October, for November judging).

<p>Assigned Subjects</p> <p>[AS_B] [AS_P] [AS_L]</p>	<p>At the beginning of each year, the CCR Board announces three special Categories referred to as "Assigned Subject" Categories for that year. The intent is to challenge our photographers to try something new, or stretch their post processing skills (since these categories allow unlimited post-processing creativity).</p> <p>For 2021 those Categories are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Back Light • Different Perspectives: Looking Up or Looking Down • Low Light
<p>Black & White Images [BW]</p>	<p>The Color Designation "BW" refers to Black & White images. They are monochrome images, including infrared photographs, produced in black and white or in varying tones of only one color. Images that are primarily monochrome but contain added color to part of the image should be submitted as Color, NOT as B&W.</p>
<p>Camera Club of Richmond Member</p>	<p>A CCR Member is one who has paid Membership Dues for the current year. All CCR Members are eligible to submit images for Image Evaluations (held during monthly CCR Meetings) as well as participate in the End of Year Competition.</p>
<p>Camera Club of Richmond Dues</p>	<p>CCR dues for FULL membership in the club are \$40.</p> <p><i>Please note: Membership in CCR MeetUp (MeetUp.com/Camera-Club-of-Richmond) is free, however if you only belong to CCRMeetUp, you are NOT eligible to submit images for Image Evaluations or participate in the End of Year Competition.</i></p>
<p>Categories</p>	<p>These are the general groups to which you will submit your images for the End of Year Competition. See the official Category list for guidance on where to place your photos or contact any CCR Board Member for help.</p>
<p>Color Designation</p>	<p>Color Designation refers to the range of colors contained in your image. Black & White (B&W) images are monochrome images, including infrared photographs, produced in black and white or in varying tones of only one color. Images that are primarily monochrome but contain added color to part of the image should be submitted as Color, NOT as B&W.</p>

	<p>Color (C) refers to images shot in full color or containing any color other than black and white.</p>
<p>Color Images [C]</p>	<p>The Color Designation Color refers to images shot in full color or containing any color other than black and white.</p>
<p><u>End of Year Competition</u> EOY</p>	<p>CCR holds a competition at the end of each year and invites members to submit up to 12 photographs to compete for awards in several different <u>Categories</u>. Up to five of those photos may be Wildcard images. The other images (called Standard images) must have been evaluated at one of the monthly CCR <u>Image Evaluations</u> during the current year.</p> <p>These photos (prints and/or digital images) are due in October and judged by a panel of professional photographers – usually from outside the Richmond area – in November. Awards are presented at our CCR Awards Banquet which is held in place of our regular CCR meeting on the second Wednesday in December.</p> <p><i>*Special Note: The 2019 Awards Banquet will be held on the FIRST Wednesday in December (the 4th) due to the unavailability of the venue on December 11th.</i></p>
<p><u>Groups</u> [A]</p> <p>[B]</p>	<p>Group A (Seasoned Exhibitor)</p> <p>Any member MAY enter images in the Group A competition.</p> <p>You are REQUIRED to compete in Group A if you have won any Camera Club of Richmond Memorial Award or have received more than 3 placed awards (1st, 2nd or 3rd place).</p> <p>Once you have competed in Group A, you must remain in this Group for all future competitions.</p> <p>Group B (Novice Exhibitor)</p> <p>This group is for new/novice CCR Members.</p> <p>In order to compete in this group, you must NOT have won any Camera Club of Richmond <u>Memorial Award</u> or have received more than 3 placed awards (1st, 2nd or 3rd place).</p> <p>Once you have won a Memorial Award, or received more than 3 placed awards, you MUST compete in the Group A category for all future competitions.</p>
<p><u>Image Evaluation</u></p>	<p>Six times a year, CCR holds an Image Evaluation during our regular monthly meeting. CCR members (who have paid their Annual Dues) are invited to submit 1 or 2 images (either prints or digital images) for review. We invite a professional/experienced photographer or local artist to review these images and provide constructive feedback to help us learn and improve as photographers.</p>

<p>JPG JPEG</p>	<p>JPG stands for Joint Photographic Experts Group. JPEG is the standard file format for compressing digital images so they can be stored or sent by email more easily. CCR requires that all images submitted for Image Evaluations and End of Year Competition are in the JPG file format.</p>
<p><u>Media Type</u> [D] [P]</p>	<p>Images may be submitted as two different Media Types; either Digital Images or Prints.</p> <p>The specific requirements for each type of submission are contained in: <u>EOY Requirements for Media Type - Digital</u> <u>EOY Requirements for Media Type - Prints</u>.</p>
<p>Naming Convention for <u>EOY Competition</u></p>	<p>The prescribed way that digital images must be named for the EOY Competition is so that the hundreds of submissions can be properly sorted and evaluated. Here is the format:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>[Media Type]</u>_<u>[Group]</u>_<u>[Category Abbreviation]</u>_ <u>[Color Designation]</u>_<u>[Title of Image]</u>_<u>[Standard or Wildcard]</u>_ <u>[Your Name]</u>.jpg</p> <p>When you name your digital files:</p> <p><u>OMIT</u> the Brackets ([])</p> <p><u>INCLUDE</u> the Underscores (_)</p> <p><u>INCLUDE</u> any necessary Spaces or Dashes in Your Name and your Image Title.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">For example, this file name:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">P_A_AS_N_BW_Double-Crossed_ST_Carol Hagaman.jpg</p> <p style="text-align: center;">would represent a [P]rint in Group [A] in the [AS]igned Subject [N]ight Photography Category [BW] Black & White Color Designation Entitled: Double-Crossed [ST]andard Image (i.e. was previously submitted for Evaluation) By Photographer: Carole Hagaman</p>

<p>Naming Convention for Image Evaluation of an Assigned Subject</p>	<p>The prescribed way that digital images must be named for the Image Evaluations is so that the dozens of submissions can be properly sorted and evaluated. Here is the format you must use for an Assigned Subject:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">[Media Type]_[Title of Image]_[Your Name]_[AS].jpg</p> <p>When you name your digital files:</p> <p><u>OMIT</u> the Brackets ([])</p> <p><u>INCLUDE</u> the Underscores (<u> </u>)</p> <p><u>INCLUDE</u> any necessary Spaces or Dashes in Your Name and your Image Title.</p> <p>For example, this file name:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">P_The Eyes Have It_Phillip Snider_AS.jpg</p> <p>would represent a [P]rint Entitled: The Eyes Have It By Photographer: Phillip Snider [AS] for Assigned Subject: Oh Those Eyes</p>
<p>Standard Images [ST]</p>	<p>Standard Images are those images that were submitted for Image Evaluations during the current year. You are allowed to submit up to 12 Standard Images for the EOY Competition.</p>
<p>Wildcard Images [WC]</p>	<p>Wildcard Images are those images that were NOT submitted for an Image Evaluation during the current year. FIVE of the images you submit for the EOY Competition may be Wildcards. And, yes – you may submit just the five Wildcard images if you wish. There is no requirement to submit Standard Images at all.</p>
