



CCR MeetUp: Managing MeetUp Emails

We know! MeetUp can send a LOT of emails!

You can choose which emails you receive from each of your Meetup groups, and you also have the option to unsubscribe from specific MeetUp emails.

Here's how:



Desktop instructions to Edit Email Notifications:

1. Go to www.MeetUp.com
2. Click on your circular **Profile Picture** in the upper right-hand corner.
3. Select **Settings**.
4. Select **Email Updates**.
5. To disable most emails, select **Turn Off**.
