Ken Conger presents at our June meeting

Ken Conger, presentation, Four Continents of Critters

After a rewarding 30 year career as a Virginia game warden and Alaska park ranger, Ken Conger has carried his motivation and enthusiasm for wildlife protection over to his passion for wildlife photography. He has attained both a Bachelor of Science degree in Wildlife Management and a Master of Science degree in Administration of Justice.

Ken's interest in photography began at a young age. Wildlife photography has always been his concentration. The majority of his images utilize available early morning and late afternoon light to capture the natural color and beauty of wildlife. His photographs are primarily taken within National Parks and Fish & Wildlife Refuges and are strictly images of wild animals.

An award winning photographer (National Wildlife Federation, National Parks Competition, Sony International Photography Contest, Popular Photography), Ken's images have adorned a number of magazine covers and calendars. Ken currently teaches wildlife photography through full day classes and private lessons, leads international photo tours and participates in art festivals along the east coast.

His presentation to the club will be on four continents of critters.

The club has signed with the Art Works to have a Club showing in their Skylight Gallery Starting on September 28th ending on October 20th.

Skylight Gallery will hold about 18 pictures for display.

Please read the following important details explaining the selection process and time lines for entries to be selected and the final delivery date prior to setting up the show.



Digital entries max of 2 per person can now be submitted to the Digital Director, at digital@cameraclubofrichmond.com No more than one photo will be selected from each person's entries, allowing more club members having their photos displayed.

Your submittal should be sent with the subject lines listed below, if they do not contain this format they will not be accepted. The digital photo should be 19200 at its longest side.

Time Lines

Last day for entries is July 15th, notification on the selected photos will be sent on August 4th.

The selected photos will require a \$10.00 fee to support the rental and some food on the 4th Friday opening. The selected photos cannot be larger than 24" outside frame or hanging dim. The finished print must have a wire hanging support, or they will not be entered for hanging.

The selected framed, completed photos must be delivered to the Art Works between Sept 22nd and Sept 23rd for hanging in the Skylight Gallery. Bob Papas will be there to receive them or they can be left with the Art Work's staff who will store them for us.

Removal of the prints will be on October 21st you must pick up your prints on this date. Art Works 4th Friday on September 28th will kick off our Gallery display, starting time is 600 PM to 9:00 PM. The prints will hang in the Gallery until October 21st, they will be for sale, the Art Works will charge 35 % commission on the sale, make sure you price your print accordingly you don't want to lose money on it.
